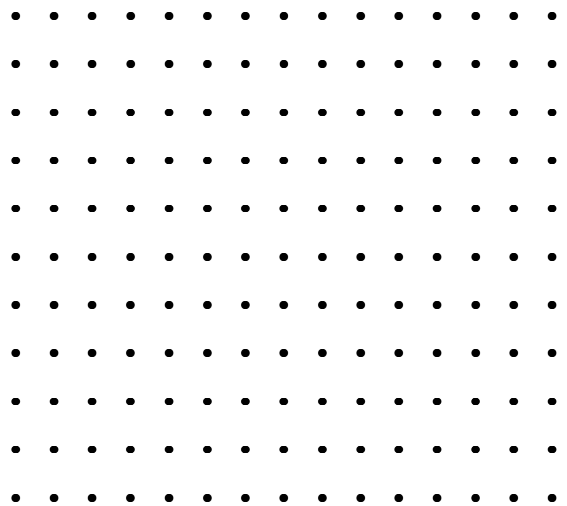
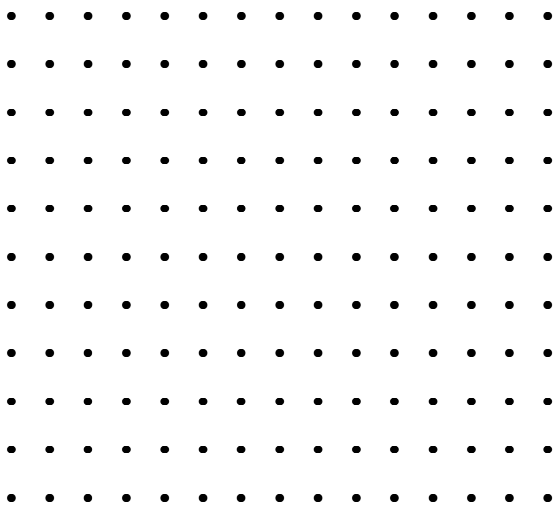
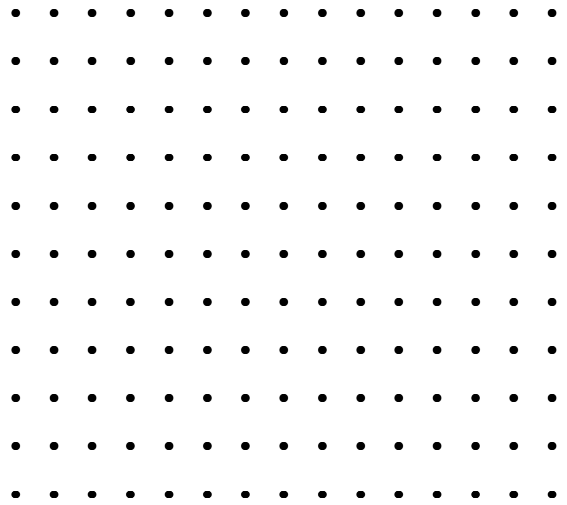
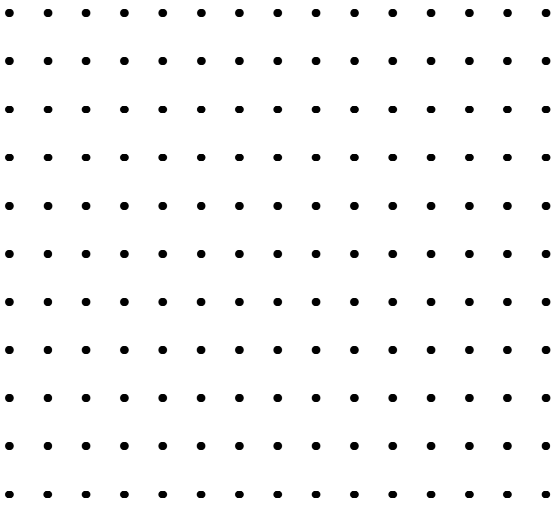
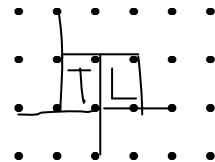


Lines and Dots Game



This is a game for two or more people:

- ✈ Print the template, or make your own game board, using a blank sheet of paper and fill a section of it (or the whole thing) with evenly spaced rows of dots about a centimetre apart,
- ✈ Take turns drawing horizontal or vertical lines between adjacent dots connecting them together,
- ✈ If you complete a full square, write your initial in the box and take another turn. If your line creates two boxes, then you get to put your initial in both of them,
- ✈ Continue playing until all the dots on the page are connected,
- ✈ Count how many boxes each player has on the page. The player with the most boxes wins!
